

Mayor Coleman to Sign GE Wind Turbine Blade as it Travels through Columbus on a National Tour

The Mid-Ohio Regional Planning Commission's annual Clean Air Fair will feature a wind turbine blade on Nationwide Boulevard in the Arena District. Mayor Michael B. Coleman will sign the blade, demonstrating his support of America's clean energy future. The 131-foot display, transported via semi truck, is making a stop in Columbus as part of General Electric's national tour to build awareness of renewable energy.

“Conservation is the best strategy to reduce our impact on the environment,” Mayor Coleman said. “But when we’ve conserved all we can, looking to renewable sources of energy is key to going green in the City of Columbus.”
